- 2- Top-4 players in both boys and girls singles event and Top-2 pairs in each pair event based on the **BAI RANKING POINTS** after the conclusion of below-mentioned three U-19 tournaments
  - a) U-19: All India Jr Ranking Tournament, Bengaluru (09-15 April 2022)
  - b) U-19: All India Jr Ranking Tournament, Panchkula (07-13 July 2022)
  - c) U-19: All India Jr Ranking Tournament, Goa (15-21 July 2022)
- 3- Top-4 in both boys and girls singles event and Top-2 pairs in each pair event from the above-mentioned three U-19 tournaments.
- 4- Top-2 in both boys and girls singles of U-17 event and Winning pairs in each pair event of U-17 competition from
  - a) U15/U17: All India Sub Jr. Ranking Tournament, Panchkula (02-09 January 2022)
  - b) U15/U17: All India Sub Jr. Ranking Tournament, Goa (23-30 July 2022)

#### **IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR PLAYERS & COACHES**

- For the paired events, players can form pairs from the names selected in the paired events in the lists above (Annexure 2). It is mandatory for the players to obtain an NOC from their existing doubles partner in case they are changing their partner.
- If the common player is unable to provide an NOC from the dual partner, the same entry will not be accepted for the trials
- If selected for the development group/national camp, both the players will be required to furnish an undertaking that the pair will play together at least for a minimum 1-year period.
- At the playing venue, it must be noted that the entry is **strictly restricted** and except for the Technical Officials, Players and BAI Officials, NO other person such as Coaches, Parents or Media Personnel will be allowed inside FOP.
- For the 2022 BWF World Junior Championships, the team will be selected as per the following order from the selection trials-
  - 1- Top-3 players for the Boys singles
  - 2- Top-3 players for the Girls singles
  - 3- Top-2 pairs for the Boys doubles, Girls doubles & Mixed Doubles
- Final list of the players selected for the developmental group, National Camp, international competitions and the 2022 BWF World Junior Championships will be published after the Selection Trials as approved by the Selection Committee (Juniors).
- The players are required to report at the I-Sports Badminton Arena in Raipur on 11<sup>th</sup>
  August 2022. The briefing meeting will be held at 6pm on 11<sup>th</sup> August 2022.
