8. Attendance for the camp may be forwarded to the TEAMS Division on 3rd day of the camp.

9. Any inclusion/deletion of Campers/Coaches/Supporting Personnel should not be entertained

without prior approval of TEAMS Division.

10. All arrangements for the camp are to be made by Badminton Association of India as per the norms, as such 75% of the total estimated expenditure may be advanced to the BAI. On conclusion of the camp BAI shall submit all the bills/receipts in original to the Director, SAI Sub Centre, Lucknow for final settlement of advance and reimbursement of balance, if any.

11. On conclusion of the Coaching Camp, National Coach/Coach In-charge shall submit a comprehensive report on Coaching camp through the Director In-charge, SAI Sub Centre,

Lucknow within 7 days to the Executive Director (TEAMS).

12. It is mandatory for the Regional Head/Centre Head and the concerned Federation to submit monthly expenditure statement on last working day of the month and utilisation certificate within 15 days of completion of the camp to ED (Finance), SAI with copy to Executive Director

13. All bills pertaining to the camps shall be settled within 21 days of completion of the camp.

14. All the equipments (consumables and non-consumables) issued for the camp has to be entered in the stock and issue register and shall be returned to the camp Incharge on completion of the camp.

15. Attendance of all the campers is to be maintained and monitored on daily basis.
