Player's Code of Conduct	It is mandatory for the players to follow the Player's code of conduct as published by BAI & PCI.	
Classification Process	<p>Classification Test will be started by BWF Certified Classifiers and other Para Medics on 08th Sept.2025 from 08:00 AM onwards.</p> <p>It is mandatory for all players, who are not Internationally classified, to attend the Classification Test failing which they will not be allowed to participate in the Championships. The players, who were classified during the last National Championship or before but not have appeared for International Classification, will have to appear for classification again.</p> <p>The players have to bring the following documents for classification with them as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> o Filled Classification Form 1 & 2 (As attached) o Disability certificate issued by CMO, o History of all related medical documents like X. Rays, MRI etc. o Record of previous classification done (If any) o Duly filled Medical Classification and consent form in prescribed format. 	
Scoring System	BWF approved scoring system will be used. However, in case of more number of entries or other reasons, other alternative scoring system as approved by BWF may be used as per the discretion of Referee.	
Structure of fixtures	The Draws will be made by Referee based on BWF Ranking and/or National Ranking and/or Performance of previous National championships. The structure of fixtures /Draws size will depend upon the number of the entries.	
Result & Circulation System	The Draws, Match Schedule and results will be displayed on Tournament Software.	
Code /Format of Uniform	Appropriate Badminton sports clothing as mentioned in relevant regulations (wherever practical) will be followed.	

Doping	Doping control in badminton, in accordance with NADA Anti -Doping Regulations, is conducted out of- competition and in -competition with the collection of urine and/or blood samples. Athletes are responsible for any substance found in their body. Before an athlete takes any medication, they should check with their doctor, and if necessary, get a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE)
Player's protocol on Media	Players should assist media as and when advised by organisers wherever possible for photos and if this fits their competition schedule.
Photo and video material	Organisers have the right to use photographs, film material or any other image of players taken during events.
Matter of conflict or interpretation of regulations	On any dispute and/or matter of conflict and/or interpretation of rules, the decision of Tournament committee/Jury shall be final and binding on all players & officials.
